# **Fundamental principles**

- To be a member of the End FGM European Network, an organisation must:
  - Work on the issue of FGM or on other issues that are relevant to FGM: violence against women and girls (VAWG), women's rights, gender-based violence, sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), migrants' rights
  - □ Subscribe to the <u>vision, mission statement and values</u> of the Network
  - □ Sign the Charter of the Network and respect the principles spelled out therein
  - Be committed to <u>engaging in transnational work, advocacy and campaigning</u> to end FGM in the European Union

#### • All members commit to:

- □ <u>Advance the interests</u> of the Network and avoid any action which might discredit or damage the Network or interfere with the achievement of its aims
- <u>Support</u> the Network's objectives and activities as described in the strategic plan and annual work plans
- □ Agree with and respect their membership <u>rights and responsibilities</u>

## **Becoming a member**

- The End FGM European Network has two types of membership with distinct rights and responsibilities
  - Full member
  - □ Associate member

### • Which membership could your organisation apply for?

### Full membership eligibility criteria

To become a **full member**, an organisation must:

- □ Be a national Civil Society Organisation working on FGM with a human rights-based approach and,
- □ Be legally registered in one of the European Union Member States and,
- $\hfill\square$  Work in accordance with the laws in force within their country and,
- $\Box$  Have governing bodies elected by their members <u>and</u>,
- □ Ensure that its statements and positions reflect the views and opinions of its memberships, and that consultation procedures with the membership are in place <u>and</u>,



 Dedicate a significant part of its annual activities on FGM in the EU Member State where it is legally registered

#### Associate membership eligibility criteria

To become an **associate member**, an organisation must:

- □ Be a European Union formal or informal CSO or research organisation or private body working on FGM <u>or</u>,
- □ Be a European formal or informal CSO or research organisation or private body working on FGM <u>or</u>,
- □ Be an International formal or informal CSO or research organisation or private body working on FGM <u>or</u>;
- Be a national CSO working on FGM and fulfilling criteria for full membership, but which cannot become full member due to <u>country quotas</u> already achieved. NB: National CSOs fulfilling criteria for full membership should complete the application form for full membership. It is the Board that will determine whether, due to country quota the applicant organisation will rather have associate membership.

# Becoming an Ally of End FGM EU

#### Friends of End FGM criteria

Individuals or organisations who want to become allies with End FGM EU and support its vision and mission can apply to become an official "Friend of End FGM EU".

To become a Friend of End FGM EU an organisation or individual must:

- □ Be a civil society organization with a human rights approach, and legally registered in a European country that:
- does not conduct any work on FGM
- works on other relevant areas such as violence against women and girls, women's rights, gender-based violence, sexual and reproductive health and rights, migrant rights (non-exhaustive list)
  - Be an individual who resides within the Europe, whose expertise is considered valuable to the Association
  - □ Be any organisation or individual approved by the Board, concerned with furthering the objectives of End FGM EU.
