







# 15 STATE PARTIES TO THE CONVENTION

- ✓ Opening for signature : 11 May 2011
- ✓ Entry into force: 1 August 2014

#### **State Parties:**

Albania, Andorra, Austria, Bosnia Herzegovina, Denmark, Spain, France, Italy, Malta, Monaco, Montenegro, Portugal, Serbia, Slovenia, Sweden, Turk 22 signatories


