

Terms of Reference

The development of an Online Interactive Map on FGM for the End FGM European Network

1. End FGM European Network

The End FGM European Network (End FGM EU) is an umbrella network of 30 national organisations working in 14 European countries and who are expert on Female Genital Mutilation (FGM). End FGM EU operates as a meeting ground for communities, civil society organisations, decision-makers and other relevant actors at European level to interact, cooperate and join forces to end all forms of FGM in Europe and beyond. We put at the heart of our work grassroots voices to influence European governments and policy-makers to work towards the elimination of FGM. We build our members' capacity, offer spaces to share expertise and develop partnerships.

While being dedicated to being the driving force of the European movement to end FGM, we are equally committed to build bridges and cooperation with all relevant actors in the field of FGM both in Europe and globally. In this sense, we actively promote and foster cooperation between the European movement and movements in other regions of the world.

2. End FGM EU Online interactive Map: Purpose and scope

End FGM EU would like to create a user-friendly interactive map on our website to make accessible to the public a mapping study we have conducted around laws, policies, services and data about FGM in 14 European countries. Information on these topics has been gathered through a questionnaire with limited colour-coded answers to ensure their easy visual representation. To have an idea of the kind of map and features we have in mind, please consult the <u>Sexual Rights Database</u>.

The aims of this interactive map are to:

- Provide a platform to access all relevant information regarding the laws, policies, services and data collection in 14 European countries around FGM;
- Provide a user-friendly and accessible resource for those seeking more information on FGM in Europe;
- Allow users to select information both per topic analysed (to have a comparative overview), and per country (to have a detailed in depth knowledge);
- Be able to access a list of all 14 European countries with detailed information (like this);



3. Expected Deliverables

The aim of this service is to:

- 1. Propose design options for an interactive map (preferably to be embedded on www.endfgm.eu)
- 2. Work with the End FGM EU secretariat to develop a tailor made interactive map
- 3. Train End FGM EU secretariat on the upkeep/maintenance of the interactive map

5. Timeframe

The interactive map is expected to be completed by December 2020.

6. Proposal submission

- A narrative proposal containing your ideas on the map
- A budget proposal and your realistic work timeline
- Examples of similar previous work (would be an asset)
