BEIJING+25: FGM AS A GENDER EQUALITY ISSUE

WHAT IS BEIJING+25?

In 2020, the global community marks the 25th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration. The Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action is an agreement on a comprehensive plan to achieve global legal equality between women and men. 25 years later, the Platform for Action is still relevant as a framework for holding governments to account and supporting advocacy efforts in the fight to reach gender equality.

IS FGM A GENDER EQUALITY ISSUE?

Yes, it is. FGM is a way to control women's bodies and sexuality and it is a form of gender-based violence that women and girls experience simply because of their gender.

In many contexts, FGM aims to guarantee women's "morality" and their family's honour by ensuring they remain virgin until marriage and that they are faithful once married.

FGM as a matter of gender equality was addressed in the Beijing Platform for Action, both specifically and within all forms of gender-based violence, in several critical areas of concern.
